

TDIclub Vendor Registration Application

- This application is for the privilege of posting in the vendor section of TDIclub.com, along with a listing in the registered Vendors page. You will also receive a title on your membership indicating you are a "Vendor" or "Vendor with Business Info", "Service Provider", "Service Provider with Business Info" or "Associate of <Insert Business Name>"
- To sell a product or service in the vendor section, one must be a registered member in good standing for a minimum of two months before applying to be a Registered Vendor.
- Only your Company name and product descriptions will be displayed on the website. TDIclub will provide vendor information when required but will not be responsible, in any way, for any disputes between a vendor and customer.
- It is your responsibility to update this information should it change. Failure to do so can result in a loss of privileges on TDIclub.com.
- A Registered Vendor will receive no special privileges and must still abide by the TDIclub forums rules described on the website here: (<http://www.tdiclub.com/Disclaimer/ForumRules.html>).
- Registered Vendors are not allowed to post in each others threads in a negative or competitive manner. If they have issues with each other, they are to contact each other directly and personally – out of the forums.
- Registered Vendors are allowed to engage in technical discussion of products in the correct discussion forums, not in the classifieds.
- These rules are subject to change. You will be notified via your e-mail information that you provide, if a change occurs for this form to be re-submitted.
- Registration is not advertising. With registration you are permitted to start a reasonable amount of topics in the vendor section. A reasonable amount will be determined by TDIclub management.
- Information submitted on the application form **will be verified**.
- Staff and associates of a vendor who post at TDIclub.com must identify themselves in their profile as such and also be listed on the form of the principal applicant, or submit a validation form of their own, if theirs is a separate business entity.
- The TDIclub forums are **NOT** webpages for a vendor. Rather a mechanism to help members find products they may be interested in. This means no linked PayPal or "shopping cart" buttons in any part of your posts or signature, catalogues, daily 'bumps', etc.
- The current vendor registration is subject to change without notice
- A vendor is anyone who sells more than a few items kicking around his/her garage.
- Vendors group buys are limited to no repeated products within a three (3) month period.
